STANDING ORDERS COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

June 1, 2006

Agenda item #2, Discussion, recommendation, and possible action on requests for waivers of prescriptive delegation requirements. There were none.

Agenda item #3, Report on waivers acted upon by staff. There were none.

Agenda item #4, Discussion, recommendation, and possible action proposed amendments to Chapter 193, Standing Orders:

- A. Repeal of 193.11, Use of Lasers and new 193.11 Prescription Medical Devices. Following discussion of the draft of 193.11 Prescription Medical Devices, Dr. Garza moved, Dr. Miller seconded, to direct staff to make changes in the draft as discussed and to proceed with review of the draft rules with stakeholders. The recommendation of the stakeholders should then be brought back to the Standing Orders Committee for review and possible action. All voted in favor. The motion passed.
- B. New 193.12, Immunizations of Elderly. Following discussion, Dr. Miller moved to publish the rules as proposed in the Texas Register for public comment. Dr. Garza seconded. All voted in favor and the motion passed.
