

TEXAS MEDICAL RADIOLOGIC TECHNOLOGY BOARD

LICENSURE COMMITTEE

MEETING MINUTES

November 15, 2016

The meeting was called to order at 9:23 a.m. by Chair, Jennifer C. Flanagan, MRT. Committee members present were Nicholas M. Beckmann, M.D., Joe Chien-Yuan Chow and Carol Waddell, MRT.

Agenda Item 2 - Applicants appearing concerning eligibility.

Applicant #1921 appeared before the Committee on referral by the Executive Director. The applicant presented a brief summary and the Committee members asked questions. Following discussion, **Mr. Chow moved that the applicant be granted a full Medical Radiologic Technologist certificate under an Agreed Order subject to the following terms and conditions:**

- **Referral to the Texas Physician's Health Program (TPHP)**

This recommendation is due to the applicant's intemperate use of a controlled substance and criminal history. **Dr Beckmann seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.**

Applicant #1922 appeared before the Committee on referral by the Executive Director. The applicant presented a brief summary and the Committee members asked questions. Following discussion, **Dr. Beckmann moved that the committee recommend to the full Board that the applicant be granted a Limited Temporary Medical Radiologic Technician certificate. Ms. Waddell seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.**

Applicant #1920 appeared before the Committee on referral by the Executive Director. The applicant presented a brief summary and the Committee members asked questions. Following discussion, **Ms. Waddell moved that the committee recommend to the full Board that the applicant be referred to the Texas Physician's Health Program and upon receipt of resolution be placed on the NCT registry. The motion failed for lack of a second.**

Following further discussion, **Dr. Beckmann moved that the applicant be determined ineligible for placement on the NCT registry due to the applicant's current felony charge which may result in a felony conviction.** This recommendation is due to the applicant's history drug dependency, criminal history and recent sobriety date. **Mr. Chow seconded the motion. Dr Beckmann, Mr. Chow and Ms. Flanagan voted in favor. Ms. Waddell abstained. The motion passed.**

Applicant #1939 appeared before the Committee on referral by the Executive Director. The applicant presented a brief summary and the Committee members asked questions. Following discussion, **Dr. Beckmann moved that the committee recommend to the full Board that the applicant be granted a Medical Radiologic Technician certificate. Mr. Chow seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.**

Applicant #1925 appeared before the Committee on referral by the Executive Director. The applicant presented a brief summary and the Committee members asked questions. Following discussion, **Dr. Beckmann moved that the committee recommend to the full Board that the applicant be privately referred to the Texas Physician's Health Program and upon receipt of resolution be granted a Temporary Limited Medical Radiologic Technician certificate. Mr. Chow seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.**

Applicant #1933 appeared before the Committee on referral by the Executive Director. The applicant presented a brief summary and the Committee members asked questions. Following discussion, **Ms. Waddell moved that the committee recommend to the full Board that the applicant be granted a Medical Radiologic Technician certificate. Dr. Beckmann seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.**

Applicant #1934 appeared before the Committee on referral by the Executive Director. The applicant presented a brief summary and the Committee members asked questions. Following discussion, **Ms. Waddell moved that the committee recommend to the full Board that the applicant be granted a Medical Radiologic Technician certificate. Dr. Beckmann seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.**

Applicant #1929 appeared before the Committee on referral by the Executive Director. The applicant presented a brief summary and the Committee members asked questions. Following discussion, **Dr. Beckmann moved that the applicant be granted a Medical Radiologic**

Technologist certificate, under a non-disciplinary Remedial Plan with the following conditions:

- **4 hours of continuing medical education in Ethics**
- **120 days to pay the \$500 administrative fee**

This recommendation is based on submitting a false statement to the Board. **Ms. Waddell seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.**

Applicant #1919 appeared before the Committee on referral by the Executive Director. The applicant presented a brief summary and the Committee members asked questions. Following discussion, **Mr. Chow moved that the applicant be granted a Medical Radiologic Technician certificate under an Agreed Order subject to the following terms and conditions:**

- **Referral to the Texas Physician's Health Program (TPHP)**

This recommendation is due to the applicant's criminal history. **Ms. Waddell seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.**

Applicant #1941 appeared before the Committee on referral by the Executive Director. The applicant presented a brief summary and the Committee members asked questions. Following discussion, **Dr. Beckmann moved that the applicant be granted a Medical Radiologic Technologist certificate under a non-disciplinary Remedial Plan with the following conditions:**

- **4 hours of continuing medical education in Ethics**
- **120 days to pay the \$500 administrative fee**

This recommendation is based on the applicant's submission of a false statement to the Board. **Ms. Waddell seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.**

Applicant #1931 appeared before the Committee on referral by the Executive Director. The applicant presented a brief summary and the Committee members asked questions. **Dr. Beckmann moved that the committee recommend to the full Board that the applicant's appeal is denied and the original determination stands. Further, the applicant will be**

required to reappear before the committee after the December 31, 2016 which is the deadline for the applicant to be evaluated by the PHP.

Applicant #1932 appeared before the Committee on referral by the Executive Director. The applicant presented a brief summary and the Committee members asked questions. Following discussion, **Ms. Waddell moved that the committee recommend to the full Board that the applicant be placed on the NCT registry. Dr. Beckmann seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.**

Applicant #1924 appeared before the Committee on referral by the Executive Director. The applicant presented a brief summary and the Committee members asked questions. Following discussion, **Ms. Waddell moved that the applicant be granted a Temporary Medical Radiologic Technologist certificate under an Agreed Order subject to the following terms and conditions:**

- **Referral to the Texas Physician's Health Program (TPHP)**

This recommendation is based on the applicant's criminal history and intemperate use of drugs. **Dr. Beckmann seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.**

Applicant #1947 did not appear before the Committee, but requested consideration of their application upon on referral by the Executive Director. Board staff presented a brief summary and the Committee members asked questions. Following discussion, Dr. Beckmann moved to recommend to the full board that the applicant not be granted another attempt at passing the required examination for licensure. Further, the applicant has a remedy by re-entering and completing an approved limited certification program. **Ms. Waddell seconded the motion. All voted in favor. The motion passed.**

Agenda Item 3 - Proposed licensure agreed orders or remedial plans offered by the Executive Director. Ms. Johnston reported on **9** remedial plans offered by the Executive Director and accepted by applicants. **Dr. Beckmann moved that the 9 remedial plans be approved. Ms. Waddell seconded. All voted in favor. The motion passed.**

Agenda Item 4 - There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at **11:58 a.m.**
