MINUTES OF THE
DISCIPLINARY PROCESS REVIEW COMMITTEE
June 22, 2024 9:44 am

Manuel Quinones, Jr., M.D., Committee Chair, called the meeting to order at 9:44 a.m. Other members present were Sharon Barnes, Devinder S. Bhatia, M.D., James S. Distefano, D.O. LuAnn Morgan, Jason K. Tibbles, M.D., David Vanderweide, M.D., and Sherif Zaafran, M.D. Robert Gracia did not attend.

Agenda Item #2. Texas Physician Health Program (TXPHP).

A. Discussion, recommendation, and possible action regarding referrals.

Ms. Barnes moved and Dr. Vanderweide seconded that TXPHP Case No. 15-0191-B MD be returned to the jurisdiction of the TMB and not returned to TXPHP without a public referral. Motion carried
