December 7, 2023 9:40 am

David G. Vanderweide, M.D., Acting Committee Chair, called the meeting to order at 9:40 a.m. Other members present were Sharon Barnes, Devinder S. Bhatia, M.D., James S. Distefano, D.O., Robert Gracia, LuAnn Morgan, Jason K. Tibbles, M.D., and Sherif Zaafran, M.D. Manuel Quinones, Jr., M.D., was not present.

Agenda Item #2. Texas Physician Health Program (TXPHP).

A. Discussion, recommendation, and possible action regarding referrals.
