## Substantial Equivalence Packet Authority of School to Grant Degrees

Board rule 163.5(c)(4)(D) relates to the authority of the medical school to grant degrees in the country in which the school is located. It requires verification from the country's educational agency confirming the validity of the school.

To demonstrate this authority, the applicant must contact the education agency in the country where the medical school is located and request that the agency submit a letter directly to the board attesting to the degree granting authority of the medical school. A copy of Form Z7 must be attached as a cover sheet to the letter.
